10 Most Common Terms to describe wines

Aroma or Bouquet – the smell of wine se: fruits, herbs flowers, earth, grass, tobacco, butterscotch, toast, vanilla, mocha & chocolate

Body – light bodied, medium or full

Crisp – white wines with refreshing acidity

Dry – either dry, off-dry (or semi-sweet) or sweet

Finish – the impression a wine leaves in the back of your mouth & in your throat

Flavor Intensity – strong or weak flavor determines pairing with food

Fruity – does not imply sweet, can smell with nose, mouth & retronasal passage

Oaky – oak flavors (smoky toasty) often from storage in oak barrels

Soft – smooth rather than crisp mouth fee, typically a low amount of acidity

Tannic – red wines, leaves the mouth dry, can also taste bitter
